Applicant Information Sheet

To apply for the scholarship, you need to submit:

1. Completed application form including copy of income tax return to verify income.
2. Three letters of recommendation. These letters should not be from family members. Please provide those writing your recommendations with the enclosed general information sheet and a stamped envelope. Be sure to allow enough time for your letters of recommendation to be written and sent.
3. Transcript from college or other post secondary institution. Be sure to allow several weeks for your transcripts to be sent.
4. Nomination form from sponsoring NCHBA member. Please provide the person nominating you with the enclosed nomination form, general information sheet and a stamped envelope.

The following guidelines will apply in accepting applications for the NCHB Educational & Charitable Foundation, Inc. Scholarships:

Eligibility: Scholarships will be awarded to students nominated by members of NCHBA. Four year college students entering their junior or senior year, or two year technical school students entering their second year, who have declared their major in a construction related field may be nominated. Nominees shall be immediate family members (related by blood, ie. children, step-children or grandchildren; students related by marriage, ie. son-in-law, daughter-in-law, etc. shall not be eligible) of NCHBA member firms pursuing a career in the home building industry. Immediate family members of any current trustee of the NCHB Educational & Charitable Foundation, Inc. shall not be eligible. Student must be taking a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester to be eligible.

Length of Time: Initial scholarships will be for one year. Scholarship winners will be eligible for consideration for renewal if they maintain satisfactory progress in their studies. Scholarships will be awarded for a maximum of 4 semesters for college or university students and 2 semesters for technical school students.

Criteria: Scholarships will be based on a combination of need and merit as determined by the Board of Trustees. First preference will go to students attending college or technical school in North Carolina. Scholarship applications will include information on grades, achievements and financial need.

Scholarship Number & Amount: The number of scholarships and the amount of each scholarship will be determined by the Board of Trustees based on the availability of funds.

Timetable: Scholarship applications will be accepted beginning with the fall term each year and the Board of Trustees will meet in the spring to select the scholarship recipients. The scholarship winners will be announced each year no later than July.
